CUBE Color 14 features the new LECHUZA wick system. It keeps your potted herbs fresh longer even without repotting thanks to the LECHUZA irrigation system.

Planting CUBE Color 14 is easy: Simply insert the wick attached to the spear into one of the holes on the bottom of the grow pot. Place the grow pot into CUBE Color 14, fill the water reservoir and your plants will get all the water they need to grow via the wick. The integrated water level indicator shows you when it's time to water again. Now hobby chefs and people who love herbs can very quickly and easily present their plants in a decorative way and enjoy them much longer because they stay fresh.

CUBE Color 14 is the square counterpart to the spherical LECHUZA-PURO 20. This new cube-shaped model for herbs features a surprisingly realistic woven structure and comes in the colors white, slate and the new color lime green. Whether side by side in uniform shades or in an arrangement with mixed colors – this new “herb garden” adds freshness to the kitchen on two levels.

CUBE Color 14 is designed for all standard round grow pots with a diameter of up to 12 centimeters (4.7 inch) (square grow pots also fit if their side dimensions do not exceed 8.5 centimeters (3.35 inch)).

The CUBE Color 14 model will be available in stores January 2016 and includes a planter liner and water level indicator.
